to me to be reputable and entitled to Credit  
and who being duly sworn according to  
Law, upon his oath declares that he is the  
Identical B. D. Hogle who was late Asst  
Surgeon of the 6. Regiment of Mounted  
Infantry Volunteers, and that James C.  
Montgomery while in said Service in  
line and discharge of duty at or near  
Provous Mills Perry County County  
Tennessee, became disabled in the following  
Manner viz -

He was accidentally shot by one of his Comrade Soldiers the ball entering the ins-  
tip of the left foot passing on the inside of the metatarsal bone injuring the flexor  
muscle coming out in the hollow of the foot the said Soldier had been sent

on a scout with a posse of Soldiers into Perry County and was in the line of his duty as a Soldier I treated the Wounds for two months or more before he was able to walk without the use of his Crutches after the Regt was ordered to Dec. 54 Nashville & N. W. Va. About August 1864 he so far recovered as to do Lite duty but was Compelled to use Crutches to aid him in walking he was discharged in the Spring or Summer of 1865

I treated him the said Soldier at Nashville & also at Gallatin Tenn. at the time of his discharge the wound was healed but he had tenderness of the parts and he had Partial Anchlosis of the Left Ankle joint and in my opinion could not do more than one fourth the Manual Labor of a sound able bodied man And I further state that I have no interest either direct or indirect in the prosecution of this claim for pension My means of knowing is from the fact

was in charge of the Sick almost the entire time
