 Personally appeared before me
 John McMillan Clerk of the County
 Court it being a Court of Record within
 and for the County and State aforesaid
 James C. Montgomery age 54 years
 a Resident of the County of Decatur
 and State of Tennessee who being duly
 sworn according to Oath declared that
 he is the identical James C. Montgomery
 who was enrolled on the 15 day of April
 1864 in Company C of the 3rd Regiment
 of Tennessee Mounted Infantry
 and was honorably discharged at Nashville
 Tennessee on the 6 day of May
 1865 that his personal description is as
 follows. Age 54 years. Height 5 feet
 eight inches. Complexion Dark hair Blue Eyes
 Hair gray. That while a member of the organiza-
 tion aforesaid in the Service and
 in the line of his duty at Brownsville
 in the State of Tennessee on the day
 of 1864 he was shot through
 the left foot in the instep of the foot
 which disables him greatly from

 doing almost any thing of work
 and at times I suffer considerably
 with pain in my foot and ankle
 and at times, unable to walk -

 That he had not been employed in
 the Military or Naval Service otherwise
 than as stated above

That since leaving the Service this app-
 licant has Resided in the County
 of Decatur in that State of Tennessee
 and his occupation has been that of
 a Farmer. That prior to his entry into
 the Service above named he was a man
 of good sound physical health being
 when Enrolled a Farmer that he is now
 greatly disabled from obtaining his
 Subsistence by Manual Labor by Reason
 of his injuries above described Received
 in the Service of the United States and
 he therefore makes this declaration for the
 purpose of being placed on the Invalid
 Pension Roll of the United States
 Her hereby appoints with full power.
