Personally appeared James G. Mount-
gomery whose Postoffice address is Scotts Hill
County of Henderson and State of Tennessee
who being duly sworn upon his oath declares as follows
That he is the identical James G. Mountgomery
whom has an file in the Pension office a Declara-
tion for Invalid Pension No 380524.

also depose and says that his Residence for five
years immediately preceding his enlistment
was in Decatur County Tennessee Postoffice
Scotts Hill Tennessee, and has been during the period
from his Discharge to the present time, and has been
a farmer during the time above stated

and that he was wounded in line of duty whilst
as a Scout in Perry County Tennessee at founding
Brooks Mill, Arundelley, a soldier at that time by
the names of Baze Morgan of Co. 2 Tennessee Vet
Infantry and was with me on said Scout above
mentioned, and his gun went off and the Ball
entered the instep of my left foot and pass through
my foot and cut near my heel, this being in
May or June 1864 when I was wounded as a

above stated, which disables him very much
from following his occupation as a farmer
also says that A. H. Steagall was commanding the
Scout at the time I was shot, he claimed to be a
Commission officer I do not know as to his being
an officer, at the time he was the only soldier
on the Scout that claimed to be a Commission
officer, he is a citizen of "Lebanon" County not-

I was never treated in a hospital for said wound.. was treated in Camp by Dr Moyle the Surgeon of said Regiment and the assistant Surgeon Dr Colles. This whereabout is unknown to me if living I have done some labor as a farmer since his charge but not able at any time to call to mind as my left ankle give out and pains me..

Dr P W Austin of Scotts Hill Henderson County Tennessee dressed my wound immediately on my arrival to Camp from off of the above Scott at which time I was wounded as within stated..

I am unable to prove by any soldier that was on the Scout with me at the time I was wounded.. as there was but six or seven of us - and I am informed that they are all dead - except A. A. Steagall I have seen
