Declaration for Increase of Pension.

Act of June 27, 1890.

TO BE EXECUTED BEFORE AN OFFICER AUTHORIZED TO ADMINISTER OATHS FOR GENERAL PURPOSES.

State of Tennessee, County of Decatur

On this 18th day of November, A. D. 1901, personally appeared

before me the undersigned, duly authorized to administer oaths within and for the County and State aforesaid

Jas. G. Montgomery aged 45 years, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares

that he is a pensioner of the United States enrolled at the rate of \$10.00 per month under Pension Certificate

No. 33,4774, by reason of partial inability to earn a support by manual labor. That he was

a Private in Co. C of the 29th Regiment of Tenn. Mtd. Infy. Vols.

That he believes himself to be entitled to an increase of pension on account of disabilities as heretofore alleged, and

also on account of Wound in foot and fallen

Have insert disabilities not previously alleged, if any.

That he served ninety days in the war of the rebellion and was honorably discharged, and makes this declaration for the purpose of being fully rated under the provisions of the Act of June 27, 1890, for disabilities as aforesaid, permanent in character and not due to vicious habits.

That he appoints EDGAR T. GADDIS, of Washington, D. C., his true and lawful attorney to prosecute his claim, and agrees to pay him the usual legal fee therefor if successful; that his Post office address is
